The meeting being mainly of a scientific and technical character in order to develop a conservation strategy, it is requested that experts appointed be specialists in the fields of the conservation of large carnivores, their prey species and habitats, protected area management, and wildlife management and research.

The results of the meeting will be presented to the Standing Committee of the Bern Convention.

Euronatur, with the support of the Frankfurt Zoological Society (ZGF) will cover the expenses for board and lodging for the participants from Albania and "The former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia".

Appointment of experts
