
Methodology for Balkan Lynx Baseline Survey

Purpose:

To systematically collect local knowledge on lynx & potential prey

Defining the study area

- Maps overlaid with 10x10 km grid
- Study area defined by available information on lynx (73 grid cells in Macedonia and 63 in Albania)
- At least 1 village randomly selected per grid cell

Questionnaire

- •Direct (face to face) interviews
- •Different target groups (hunters, game wardens, foresters, shepherds/farmers, shop-owners, random people)










Questionnaire

- •Questionnaire divided into 4 main parts:
- 1) presence and distribution of large mammals (carnivores & ungulates),
 - 2) existence of conflicts related with these species
 - 3) animal husbandry details
 - 4) information on socio-economic environment of village
- •Period of survey: August 2006 July 2007
- •Sample size: 553 interviews in Macedonia and 320 in Albania















The results of the Baseline Survey show that the Balkan Lynx still exists......

but, its population has a critical status

	MK	AL	Total
Probable presence	25	12	37
Possible presence	36	26	62
No presence	12	25	37
Grid cells surveyed	73	63	136

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Conclusions

Main threats to its survival are:

- Direct persecution
- Habitat degradation
- Decreasing population of prey (especially in Albania)
