Chinese leopard *P.p. japonensis*: 96 (44M.50F.2Unknown) in 35 institutions on 17 August 1995.

Ceylon/Sri Lankan leopard *P.p. kotiya*: 40 (14M.26F) in 16 institutions on 17 August 1995.
