SOM F1. Pole net used for trapping. The trapping is carried out by three persons, each carrying a pole net, walking through the plantation at night and spotting the eye shine of the cats. When an animal is spotted, it is surrounded and netted by one member. The animal is then quickly anaesthetised. This method is designed for trapping leopard cats in plantations and performed by experienced research assistants, following an approved DGFC standard operations procedure.
